







2024 STRAY DOG RECLAIM RATE

The stray reclaim rate in November was even higher than October (10 out of the 16 stray dogs were reclaimed in November).



DOG OUTCOMES

The current data indicates that the number of dog outcomes being processed for each outcome type are very consistent to those numbers that were achieved in 2023. The dog intake data indicates that 47 fewer dogs have been admitted YTD in 2024 than compared to the same period in 2023, which may contribute to the lower number of dog adoptions.




CAT OUTCOMES

Cat outcomes continue to have a good year in 2024. The cat intake data indicates that 215 more cats have been admitted YTD in 2024 than compared to the same period in 2023, which is a statistic to be very proud of!




LENGTH OF STAY



Shelters have significantly improved policy-making for cats, and there is currently increased demand for cats. A low length of stay allows for high volumes of pets to be served with fewer resources. The length of stay for both species in 2024 has been lower than 2023. Cats are spending half as many days in care when compared to 2023.

YEAR TO DATE ADOPTION RETURN RATE

142 more cats have been adopted from the facility in 2024 than dogs, and fewer of them are returned. For the first time in 2024, no adopted cats were returned to the facility. More animals can be helped with fewer resources when the adoption return rate is low. A reasonable goal is less than 15% of adoptions are returned. The overall return rate for both species YTD is 10.8%
