










Pets who are "sheltered" are those that are housed on-site awaiting an outcome. Pets who are "supported" are those accessing other services such as free vaccines and microchips, low-cost spay/neuter or TNR. Combining the number of sheltered pets with the number of supported pets results in the total number of pets served.


OUTCOMES SINCE TRANSITION (8/4/24)





STRAY DOG RECLAIM RATE SINCE TRANSTION (8/4/24)

As access to relinquishment improves, stray reclaim rates should increase. Another factor to consider when calculating reclaim rates is when Animal Control Officers are successful with reuniting pets in the field those are not reflected as an intake or outcome at the animal shelter. The Emporia location currently has the highest reclaim rate of all three Prairie Paws locations. High reclaim rates keeps expenses low and reduces pressure on the adoption program.




YEAR TO DATE ADOPTION RETURN RATE

Generally a low return rate is positive and currently the return rate across both species is 7.5%.






LENGTH OF STAY
